## LIFESAVING CARE

When you have no health insurance and a low paying job, you avoid going to a doctor, but when you are having trouble breathing you get scared enough to seek help. Angela finally went to an urgent care where she was diagnosed with bronchitis and given a prescription. After two weeks she hadn't improved but couldn't afford to go back to Urgent Care. Someone she knew told her about The CARE Clinic and she called for an appointment. Angela was impressed when our volunteer physician not only listened to her chest, but put the stethoscope up to her neck to listen to her airflow. She was even more surprised when she was referred for a CT scan. Incredibly it was done the next day, the radiologist called back with the report and Dr. Kelly, our Volunteer Medical Director, told us to call the patient and tell her to go immediately to the ER. Angela ended up having emergency surgery to remove a cyst from her trachea that was slowly restricting her airway. Angela credits The CARE Clinic with saving her life. She recently returned to The CARE Clinic specifically to thank the volunteers for being there for her. Such success stories, hugs and smiles are all the payment our outstanding volunteers want or need. Thank you to all our volunteers for caring enough to share your time and talents with us and our patients. Your dedication really does make a difference.

## VOLUNTEER SPOTLIGHT-EVELINE BERNATOVITZ

The CARE Clinic provides medical and dental care for the low income, uninsured adult patients in Cumberland County and surrounding areas. The dental clinic is on Tuesday evenings and the second and fourth Wednesday evenings. Tuesday evenings the clinic is staffed with local dentists and also several dentists from Fort Bragg. The second and fourth Wednesday evenings are staffed by the dental residents from the Veterans Administration (VA). The dentists do simple extractions; which means we pull a tooth that is to the point where it cannot be restored and may be broken, but not all the way down to the gum line. Also, the clinic does not pull wisdom teeth.

The clinic is also staffed with volunteers to assist the dentists. Some of the volunteers have been coming for years and some are right out of school. Dental Assistant is one position that is frequently a challenge to staff. Eveline Bernatovitz started volunteering at The CARE Clinic in January of 1995 as a dental assistant. She came to The CARE Clinic while working at Fort Bragg in the Smoke Bomb Dental Clinic with Dr. Chupkowski and Dr. Barbaro, who were both instrumental in getting our dental clinic started. Dr. Chupkowski continues to be the Dental Director here. Eveline also attended St. Patrick's Catholic Church that was and continues to be a dedicated supporter of The CARE Clinic and also influenced Eveline to start volunteering.

Eveline was very knowledgeable and was always willing to teach the new volunteers and new graduates. The CARE Clinic purchased a new hand held X-ray machine called the Nomad Pro. Eveline reviewed the educational materials, learned how to use the device and instructed others on its use. If there was a need for a volunteer, Eveline could always be counted on to pitch in and help.

Eveline recently moved to Charlotte to be closer to family and we feel the void. We recently came close to cancelling a dental clinic because we had nobody to do the X-rays. Eveline volunteered at The CARE Clinic for

She said there are several free dental clinics close to where she lives and she is considering volunteering, stating, "I hope to add that to my schedule; it's good for the soul and it's a great way to meet wonderful people". # NC MISSIONS OF MERCY FREE DENTAL CLINIC

The CARE Clinic proudly hosted our fourth NC Missions of Mercy Free Dental Clinic on October 28-29 along with our co-hosts Better Health and Operation Inasmuch. As usual, patients were already lined up outside the Crown Arena on Thursday morning when we arrived to start setting up the clinic. Over the two days, volunteers provided free dental care to 811 patients valued at \$467,956.39. This included 721 routine extractions, 429 surgical extractions, 42 partials, and 5 root canals.

NC Missions of Mercy is an outreach program of the NC Dental Society which provides free dental services to low income patients who otherwise would have no access to dental care. The clinic provides free cleanings, fillings, extractions, and front partials. This year a local dental practice also provided free root canals to our MOM patients at their office.

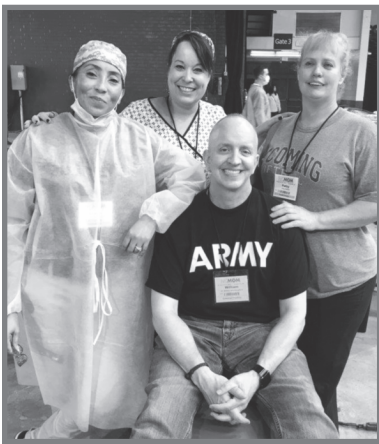
Friday morning the 86 chair clinic got off to a great start with patients being screened based on the number of volunteer dental professionals who had signed up to volunteer that day. However, Friday afternoon 11 dentists who had signed up did not show up. We suspect those dentists coming in from out of town had been following the news reports about the devastating flooding and road wash outs the Fayetteville area had suffered from Hurricane Matthew less than three

weeks earlier and assumed the clinic had been cancelled. On the other hand, a military dentist and his dental assistant wife who had volunteered at The CARE Clinic while stationed at Fort Bragg flew in from Alaska to volunteer at the clinic! (See military volunteers article.)

Governor Pat McCrory, Fayetteville's Mayor Nat Robertson, and Senator Wesley Meredith even came through our clinic Friday afternoon as they toured local damages from the storm. Some of the patients who had been screened and waited all day Friday had to come back on Saturday to receive their services. Saturday was much better as the dental students from UNC and ECU dental schools showed up to help. All 86 dental chairs were in full operation all day!

We sincerely appreciate our sponsors - the Walmart State Giving Program, Florence Rogers Charitable Trust and the Elizabeth A. Hudspeth Endowment Fund at Cumberland Community Foundation for helping us satisfy the Dental Society's requirement to contribute \$40,000 towards the cost of the clinic. The clinic would not have happened without the support of our in kind donors and all the volunteers who willingly shared their time and talents with the less fortunate in our community. Thank you to everyone for making a tremendous difference in the lives of so many of our patients.

## DEDICATED MILITARY VOLUNTEERS



Over the years, The CARE Clinic has been blessed with wonderful military volunteers who share their time and talents with us while being stationed at Fort Bragg. Two of our former volunteers, Dr. William MacNaughton and his wife Lluvia, deserve special recognition as they flew in from Alaska just to volunteer at our NC Missions of Mercy Free

Dental Clinic in October. I told him I would like to mention this in our newsletter and asked him for a comment. This is what he sent me:

“My wife and I enjoy volunteering to help out less fortunate people. I'm a Lieutenant Colonel in the Army, active duty. My wife, Lluvia is a Department of Defense dental assistant. We are both stationed at Ft. Wainwright, Alaska. The Army emphasizes seven core values, one of which is “selfless service.” Selfless Service is defined as putting the welfare of the nation, the Army and your subordinates before your own.”

“I always strive to live the Army values. Volunteering for the Mission

of Mercy events is a great way to give back to the community. During the Mission of Mercy event in Fayetteville, I was blessed to have 8 experienced dental assistants. My wife, Lluvia, has been a dental assistant for 10 years. She helped to assist me and to keep everything flowing. She would give guidance to other dental assistants as to what was needed next. When I was working directly with the other dental assistants, they were very experienced and that helped me greatly. During the first day of the MOM event, I was working 1-2 chairs. The second day of the MOM event I was working 3-4 chairs. In total, our dental team extracted 79 teeth.”

“Lluvia and I will be participating in the Mission of Mercy event in Charlotte in December. Then we are flying to Phoenix, AZ to participate in another Mission of Mercy event.”
