## MISSION: Nancy (*A patient's story*)

The CARE Clinic illustrates compassion for all people and puts the definition of neighbor into an enlarged context, beyond what people usually think of as a helping neighbor.

Our mission: "To provide free quality health care to the uninsured, low income patients who live in Cumberland County and to be a force for a healthier community" was certainly accomplished with a patient named "Nancy".

Nancy has seen many changes in her life, including marriage, children, grandchildren, illness, personal triumphs and devastating challenges. She became our neighbor when she was thirteen and her family moved here from South Carolina.

One challenge Nancy has seen is numerous health problems. Nancy was taken aback by the news of having nose cancer. Nancy has worked as a full-time hair stylist, but like the percentage of low income residents in Cumberland County, she did not receive health insurance from her employer. Nancy's health and spirit faltered and she needed help. "I heard about The CARE Clinic through a friend at work," says Nancy, "and I knew that you helped people in my situation."

Nancy made an appointment and with the help of the volunteer staff and doctors, and after referrals to Duke and Chapel Hill, she was able to get the medical attention and surgery she needed to take care of her illness. "I'm really lucky to have found The CARE Clinic. I really appreciate all of the things the clinic has done for me."

The CARE Clinic is still in Nancy's life, she still uses the other services the clinic provides; from dental to medical, to just talking to the Social Worker on hand.

Nancy can no longer work because it is too painful to stand, due to her leg injuries and excruciating back pain. Nancy has some challenges in her life, but she has help from The CARE Clinic family that has the vision to provide accessible health care for the adults in Cumberland County.

## Volunteer Appreciation

This year's CARE Clinic Annual Volunteer Appreciation dinner was held on Monday, April 7. For the third consecutive year, Berean Baptist Church graciously hosted the event, providing the use of their fellowship hall, a delicious dinner, with an attentive wait staff who helped make

sure all our volunteers were well cared for. The Stars & Stripes Singers enthusiastically provided entertainment while our honored guests enjoyed their dinner.

Carol Danielson, President of the Board of Directors, welcomed everyone and spoke about the how volunteers contribute to the betterment of our society. She thanked everyone for volunteering their time and talents, and acknowledged that without our volunteers, The CARE Clinic would not exist.

Outstanding volunteers or volunteer groups in four categories were recognized with Volunteer of the Year Awards:

The Administrative Volunteer of the Year Award was presented to Carrie Carroll. In September 2004, Ms. Carroll responded to an ad in the newspaper announcing a volunteer training session. She started serving as a receptionist during evening clinics, and her involvement grew from there. She joined our Volunteer Committee and actually offered to serve as chair. This led immediately to her election as a member of the Board of Directors and the Executive Committee, which requires more bimonthly meetings. During these meetings, Ms. Carroll will often hear about another committee's needs and she will then attend that committee's meetings to offer her help such as manning a health fair on a weekend or drafting letters for them.

The Clinical Volunteer of the Year was presented to Karen Rose. Karen has been loyally volunteering her services as a nurse during our evening clinics at least once a month since August 1994. Karen has also served as a member of our Volunteer Services Committee since 2001.

The Group Volunteer of the Year award was presented to Carolina Imaging and was accepted by Lana Witiak. They started providing four mammograms per month in 1997. In 2007, Carolina Imaging also started providing MRIs and CTs each month. All these important diagnostic studies are provided at no charge to the patient or The CARE Clinic.

The Community Volunteer of the Year Award was presented to Ken Lancaster. Ken started volunteering with The CARE Clinic in 1992 as a member of the original steering committee that was formed to develop a free health clinic. A prominent real estate agent, Ken worked closely with Sister Jean to find the right location for the clinic and helped negotiate a very fair lease of our original building. Over the past 16 years, Ken lost a lot of sleep over our leaky roof and the best way to deal with it. He is always very concerned about being good stewards of our donors' funds so he really hesitated about committing to a new building, but when a structural engineer said it would cost more to renovate the old building than to build a new clinic, Ken stepped up to the challenge. Ken guided the Board through every step of the construction process, often using his contacts in the community to get donated or discounted services.

We appreciate our Volunteer Committee for organizing this event, adding to the excitement with door prizes and potted plants on each table which guests were allowed to take home. We also appreciate Lillian's Trophies for once again providing the plaques for our award winners. The CARE Clinic staff is honored to work with our dedicated volunteers. God bless you all!

The thieves must have been interrupted as the units themselves were not damaged and only four of our six air conditioning units were affected. We count our blessings where we find them!

Our air conditioning units are now protected by a locked fence, locks on the power supplies for each unit, and the area is monitored by an infrared surveillance camera.

We would like to extend our sincere appreciation to Bass Heating and Air Conditioning for working so hard to make sure the air conditioning in the patient care areas was back in operation by the time we held our next evening clinic.
