Of Wines & Auction Items

The aroma of Carrabba's Italian Grill's Steamed Mussels, Simmering Veal Ravioli and Sautéed Chicken Marsala welcomed guests to The CARE Clinic's 6th Annual Wine Tasting on May 4. The affair lived up to its history, providing approximately 400 guests with a fantastic evening of wine, cuisine, camaraderie, bidding and record-setting fundraising.

Held each year at the Hellenic Center of the Saints Constantine & Helen Greek Orthodox Church on Oakridge Avenue in Fayetteville, the Wine Tasting raised more than \$43,000, with a net profit of over \$37,766. All tallied, The CARE Clinic experienced a 43 percent increase over last year's profits!

Steve Zahran, of Sam Zahran & Sons, enlisted the help of nationwide wine vendors for the event, and without him, the Wine Tasting could not be a success. The vendors presented more than 80 wines, from Chardonnays, Pinot Grigios and Rieslings to Cabernets, Merlots and red blends. Wines from Chile, Italy, France, the United States and many other countries tempted the taste buds of the attendees. Each guest received a gift upon entry — a souvenir CARE Clinic wine glass, sponsored by Advantage Hospice & Home Care and The Law Firm of Hutchens, Senter & Britton. The Private Tasting Room featured more expensive wines for sponsors and special guests.

While savoring the sips of wine, many attendees staked their claims on silent auction items, feverishly penning their bids and spying for that someone who dared to raise it. Renovation Project Update

In January's newsletter, we announced our plans to install a sloped roof over our current flat roof to eliminate our leaky roof problems, and renovate the exterior to make our building maintenance free. We are pleased to announce so far we have received approval for the following grant requests for our renovation project:

Student Government Inaugural Fundraiser

For the first time this year, the Cumberland County Schools Student Government Association decided the organization should raise funds to donate to a local charity. Each of the thirteen public high schools was free to determine what they wanted to do to raise funds, but the choice of a charity was a long, highly competitive year-long process with students advocating for the charity of their choice. The CARE Clinic was chosen as beneficiary when it was reported we provided free dental care to a high school football player whose family could not afford to pay for the care he needed. At their Leader's Luncheon on May 16th, the Student Government Association presented us with a check for \$5,786.28.

The CARE Clinic is honored to be the selected recipient for the Cumberland County Schools Student Government Association's first fundraiser. We appreciate the students' hard work in raising the funds and extend our thanks to their advisors for teaching the students the importance of sharing their gifts and talents with those less fortunate members of their community.
