FRIENDS REMEMBERED

The CARE Clinic lost two very special volunteers, supporters, and members of our “family” in May, Dr. C.T. Daniel and Dottie Jurek. The above picture shows them volunteering together at our Golf Tournament in 2001.

Dr. C.T. Daniel had a longstanding interest in providing health care to the poor when he joined the steering committee to develop a free health clinic in 1992. A retired obstetrician-gynecologist, he dedicated his new found free time to overseeing the birth of The CARE Clinic. He joined the Community Relations Committee and spoke to foundations, churches, and civic groups to increase community awareness and support for our mission. He helped recruit physicians to voluntarily staff the clinic, attended indigent care conferences, and volunteered at special events. Dr. Daniel was named our Community Volunteer of the Year in 2000.

Dottie Jurek had just retired as Director of Nursing at the Southeastern Regional Rehabilitation Center when she heard about the plans for the free health clinic. She immediately immersed herself in the mission, helping develop policies, setting up the exam rooms, and orienting new volunteers. She even served as a nurse on our very first clinic night, November 16, 1993. Through the years, Dottie served on our Community Relations and Clinical Services Committees, and was elected President of the Board of Directors for FY 1999-2000. She had an enthusiasm for our mission, and would take every opportunity she could to recruit new volunteers, donors, or patients. Dottie was recognized as our Clinical Volunteer of the Year in 1998.

The CARE Clinic is a stronger organization because of the many contributions of Dr. C.T. Daniel and Dottie Jurek. We will miss both of them very much.

Board of Directors for FY 2008

The CARE Clinic marked the beginning of a new fiscal year July 1 with changes to our Board of Directors. Carol Danielson was installed as President of the Board and Joseph Boles was voted President-Elect for FY 2008. A new venue, larger crowd and higher sponsorship donations highlighted The CARE Clinic's 7th Annual Wine Tasting on May 3. The aroma of Carrabba's Italian Grill tempted attendees to the Metropolitan

Room downtown where approximately 450 guests savored an evening of wine, cuisine, cascading chocolate fountain, camaraderie, silent auction bidding, and fundraising.

The Metropolitan Room, in the former First Citizens Building at the corner of Green and Hay Streets, was the site for the event for the first time this year. The Wine Tasting & Silent Auction raised more than \$50,000, with a net profit of almost \$40,000. All tallied, The CARE Clinic experienced a 5.7 percent increase over last year's record-setting profits!

Steve Zahran of Sam Zahran & Sons enlisted the help of nationwide wine vendors for the event, and without him, the Wine Tasting could not be held. The vendors presented more than 80 wines, from Chardonnays, Pinot Grigios and Rieslings to Cabernets, Merlots and red blends. Wines from Chile, Italy, France, the United States and many other countries tempted the taste buds of the attendees. Each guest received a couple of gifts upon entry — a clip to attach to their plate to hold their wine glass while they enjoyed their food, as well as a souvenir wine glass, sponsored by Advantage Hospice & Home Care, Cumberland Anesthesia Associates, and The Law Firm of Hutchens, Senter & Britton. The Private Tasting Room featured more expensive wines for the 68 sponsors and guests who sampled this special collection.

While appreciating the sips of wine, many attendees staked their claims on silent auction items, penning their bids and then surreptitiously spying for that someone who dared to raise it. Framed art, dining packages, spa and salon treatments, a gas-powered moped, jewelry, and themed baskets were sprinkled throughout the silent auction items. Guests entered the former bank vault to bid on Carlyle & Company Jewelers' Rolex watch and jewelry pieces from David Yurman. The CARE Clinic Wine Tasting Committee Co-Chair Debra Mozingo placed the winning bid on the coveted Rolex, making for an exciting evening. The silent auction contributed approximately \$9,000 to the gross profit!

DEDICATION OF NEW CARE CLINIC PLANNED

Get ready to celebrate on Sunday, November 18! A special ceremony is being planned to dedicate The New CARE Clinic building at 239 Robeson Street and mark the 14th anniversary of the opening of the clinic that provides so much to the people of our community.

On June 28, Richard Player III told members of The CARE Clinic's Board of Directors that construction of the new clinic is on schedule and the new building will be completed on time, by Oct. 5. Player is an outgoing board member who has served two three-year terms. He joked with the others that since his time on the board is ending, perhaps the project might, too. "Does this mean we can stop the building?" he asked, laughing.

Construction will go on, though. As of late June, workers were planning to begin the drywall work inside. Ken Lancaster, the chairman of the board's facilities committee, said the project was moving along well. "As you can see, it is all coming together, and I think we will all be proud of the effort," Lancaster said.

The board members approved an extension of Lancaster's term to allow him to see the project to completion. He thanked the board and told them that as much as 40 percent of the costs of the new clinic will be covered by inkind donations. Local home interior designer Lynn Leath has agreed to donate her services to decorate the clinic. And Dick Gill of Gill Security Systems Inc. has offered to install the security system and phone system as a contribution to the project. There have been many more such generous donations of time, money and materials that will allow the clinic to serve its patients even better in years to come.

By November 18, the old clinic will be history. The Habitat for Humanity Re-Store Warehouse folks will scour the old building for any salvageable materials, from doors and cabinets to sinks and toilets. Then the clinic will be bulldozed. A parking lot will take the space. But the spirit of the clinic will be reborn in its new home right next door.

"THEY REALLY CARE"

It was the end of a 14-hour shift at work and Carole was tired and feeling a headache coming on. Her job as a restaurant cook kept her on her feet all day, six days a week, and normally she looked forward to heading home for some relaxation. But this particular day, a local church was offering free mammography screening, and she planned to take advantage of that. After her sister's death from breast cancer a few years back, her mother was especially concerned that Carole be screened for the disease regularly.

At the church, Carole also decided to accept the free physical offered to her, and to her surprise discovered that her blood pressure was dangerously high—200/100. The church volunteers were very concerned about Carole going home with such high blood pressure and advised her to go to the emergency room at a nearby hospital instead.

"But I couldn't afford that," Carole says. "I told them 'I'll go get Mama's blood pressure machine and keep a check on my blood pressure and go in if it gets worse.'" She also promised to go to a local clinic the next day.

Unfortunately, Carole couldn't afford to buy her own blood pressure medication, so after several visits to the local clinic she decided to try The CARE Clinic on a friend's recommendation.

"They have been really nice and helpful," she says. "They treat you like you're a human being. They really care about the patients."

Carole has since become a regular patient at The CARE Clinic. Doctors here have worked with her to find the right medication to control her blood pressure, which now stays somewhere around 180/70. They also advise her on ways to lose weight and makes sure she gets the medications she needs.

When asked how she feels about The CARE Clinic, Carole singles out a staff member. "Katheryn—she's been exceptional. She's been top notch," Carole says. "She got mad because one time before I was to come back for my refills, I ran out of my medication. She said 'Don't you do that! If you run out before your appointment, you call us!' They won't let me run out of my medications."

She adds, "It's really great that we have this to come to, because they work all day and then volunteer their time."

Clinic Needs Food Provider

The CARE Clinic's mission is blessed by many local church groups who generously provide delicious meals for volunteers on clinic nights. Our volunteers come here directly from work and they appreciate being able to enjoy a few minutes getting acquainted with the other volunteers over a nice dinner before taking care of our patients. We also like to provide lunch for our Board of Directors meetings that are held every other month.
