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## DR. ASKINS RETIRES – *AGAIN!*



Dr. James Askins retired – again – in December 2004. A gifted Orthopaedist, Dr. Askins began sharing his medical talents with CARE Clinic patients in 1995 by accepting our referrals in his private office. When he retired from private practice four years ago, Dr. Askins started coming to The CARE Clinic every Wednesday morning to hold an Orthopaedic clinic. On a typical day he would see from 12 to 15 patients, spending as much time as necessary with each patient to listen to their complaint and help them understand their condition and any medications he prescribed.

Dr. Askins was called back into his private practice for several months last year when one of his partners was called to active duty in the reserves. Then, earlier this year, Dr. Askins was asked to hold a biweekly follow-up clinic for patients who had been seen in the emergency department. In his active retirement, Dr. Askins was holding clinics twice a week for the hospital and every Wednesday for The CARE Clinic. The hospital clinic closed in October and the last Orthopaedic Clinic was held at The CARE Clinic on December 22, 2004.

The CARE Clinic would like to express our sincere appreciation to Dr. Askins for so generously sharing his time and talents with our patients for the past nine years. We wish him a long, happy, healthy, and restful retirement. He certainly has earned it.

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Dear Cathy,

Your letter was a nice welcome. I am delighted to hear that our military community continues to support The CARE Clinic. I am a Nurse Practitioner who was posted at Fort Bragg for many years. After retirement, I continued to work with a wonderful group of military and civilian doctors at the Internal Medicine Clinic at Womack Medical Center. As a diabetic specialist, I found myself with extra glucometers and supplies sent from different manufacturers. I decided to take them to The CARE Clinic. Dr. Sammy Choe, a wise and good friend told me about the clinic run by Sister Jean. I went to the clinic to meet and to visit. I was actually contemplating becoming a volunteer staff member when I had an offer from the Department of State Foreign Service. So after a 20 year run with the Army, I raised my hand and took the oath again. My husband Dennis, who is also retired Army, and myself found ourselves in West Africa Ghana for our first two-year tour. We were then invited to do 2 years in Islamabad Pakistan for our second tour. We have been here for 17 months and serve side by side with the military at the US Embassy Islamabad. I have been working as the Nurse Practitioner for the US Embassy and consulates in Lahore, Karachi and Peshwara. I work with a wonderful doctor named Gretchen McCoy (also State Dept.) and together with our clinic nurses there isn't much we can't do!

Living in a third world country or two of them recently puts into perspective how difficult it is to achieve success in life without health. Since our country has not yet found a way to treat all people by providing free health care – then it is left to those who have to help those who need. It is such a small price to pay to relieve a little human suffering. So I donate monthly to remind myself how lucky I am!

I will stop in and say hello when we return this summer. I wish The CARE Clinic a wonderful holiday season. What a lucky group of patients to be looked after by such a great group of volunteers.

Because of the support and dedication of our donors, volunteers, board members, church members, and others, we have sold **89** books for a profit of \$890 to The CARE Clinic! 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# CARE CLINIC VOLUNTEERS

## *Our Lifeline*

The CARE Clinic is extremely fortunate and blessed to have many volunteers who help us throughout the year. Everyone is aware that we have numerous health professional volunteers who help run our clinics. However, you may not know that we also have volunteers who work behind the scenes. Some, who don't even come to the clinic, assist us with the multiple tasks that need to be performed. Numerous doctors, dentists, chiropractors, and other specialists treat our patients in their own offices. Many area churches have groups or individuals who provide dinner for our evening clinics as well as our bi-monthly board of directors' meetings. A volunteer coordinates all of the food providers to ensure that the clinic has food for all of the evening clinics during the year. A volunteer is on call to pick up donated medicine from local doctors' offices and bring it to The CARE Clinic. Another volunteer coordinates our Medication Access Program (MAP) requests. Some people help by re-packaging the sample medicines that we receive. Volunteers come in after dental clinics to sort and sterilize the dental equipment. Several men volunteer to help us with repairs, mowing and yard work. One volunteer makes appointment reminder phone calls to the patients and work reminder calls to the volunteers for the evening clinics. Several regular volunteers assist with charts and data entry.

Board and committee members volunteer their time to attend meetings. Many also volunteer to speak to groups or organizations about The CARE Clinic or set up displays at churches or events. Our three major fundraising events, The Evening of CARE, Wine Tasting and Golf Tournament could not be held without the help of many dedicated volunteers. Our financial manager comes to the clinic on a regular basis to keep our fiscal house in order. A volunteer comes in once a week to assist with our computer and database needs. Our web site managers also put in many hours keeping the site updated. Local business owners assist us in locating other sources to provide needed services to us either donated or at a reduced cost. A local company has donated laboratory services to us for over eleven years. During the summer, we have students that help us out with whatever needs to be done. Individuals and groups assist with the many hours needed for bulk mailings. As you can see, it takes a lot of volunteers to keep The CARE Clinic up and running and we are very thankful for each and every one of them!
