SPECIAL HURRICANE KATRINA CLINIC

The CARE Clinic was privileged to participate in the care of Hurricane Katrina evacuees in a special clinic held Monday, September 12. Five Fayetteville churches had sponsored the relocation of five families from the Gulf Coast disaster area. One of our Board Members, Christin Bellian, offered to help in the relocation efforts and was asked to coordinate medical care for the ten adults and twelve children. Christin turned to The CARE Clinic, and we were glad to open our doors for this special clinic.

Since The CARE Clinic stopped seeing children in 1998, Dr. John Pollard offered to see the children in his pediatric office on Saturday, September 10th. Dr. George Poehlman and Dr. Don Maharty, clinic volunteer physicians, from Womack Army Medical Center, staffed the Monday night clinic for the adults. The patients we saw expressed their appreciation for the opportunity to receive the medical care and prescriptions they needed after the ordeal they had been through. All were looking forward to getting settled in their new home.

Since this special clinic was held, The CARE Clinic has received calls from other evacuees who have arrived in the area to live with family members. Patients who meet our eligibility criteria are receiving appointments during our regularly scheduled clinics.

Freedom from Smoking Classes

The CARE Clinic is pleased to be able to offer the American Lung Association's Freedom from Smoking Class to our patients. A dedicated CARE Clinic volunteer and registered nurse, Ms. Pat Baros recently became certified by the American Lung Association as an instructor for this course. She quickly offered to hold the class for our patients at no charge, and found a sponsor. The Spring Lake Optimist Club responded to her request by generously offering to purchase the materials and student manuals needed for the program.

Classes will be held at The CARE Clinic November 3 through December 13 from 6-8 PM. The class schedule was specifically set so that the "quit day" will coincide with the Great American Smoke Out Day, Thursday, November 17. We anticipate 25 patients will be able to take the class, more if couples share the manuals. Our patients had been asking for stop smoking classes, so we especially appreciate the generosity of Pat Baros and The Spring Lake Optimist Club for making this opportunity available for our patients.

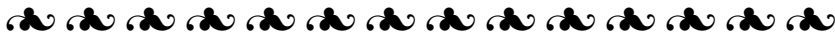
A Very Special Thanks to Our Many CARE Clinic Volunteers!

PATIENTS GIVE BACK

Our volunteers often tell us they enjoy coming down to The CARE Clinic because our patients make them feel so appreciated, and they feel like they have made a difference in someone's life when they leave. Our patients are hardworking members of our community who are sincerely grateful that we give them a "hand-up", not just a "hand-out." Some of our patients have found unexpected, unique ways to express their gratitude, such as:

- A gentleman who owns his own lawn care business donates his services every two weeks to keep our grass cut, hedges trimmed, and parking lot area looking neat and clean.
- A woman who owns a print shop supplies some of our medical forms for us at no charge.
- One patient periodically brings lunch for the Thursday afternoon clinic staff and volunteers.
- Patients occasionally donate items from our wish list.
- Several patients volunteer as receptionists for our evening clinics.

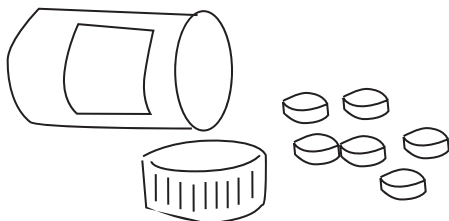
In addition, while being discharged, each patient is asked if he or she would like to make a donation to help provide care for the patients who will follow them. Each year our patients contribute about \$10,000 to help support the operations of The CARE Clinic. Since opening in November 1993, this has accumulated to an impressive amount, slightly over \$100,000 contributed by our patients.



MARP Update

In May of 2005, two CARE Clinic volunteers and one staff member went to Raleigh for training on the Medication Access and Review Program, a software program designed to help manage free medication orders for North Carolina residents who are uninsured or underinsured. The program was developed by Advanced Information Solutions, Inc., a North Carolina corporation based in Raleigh, that aids in research and development.

In June, the MARP program was installed on The CARE Clinic's computer system and has been in use since that time. Currently, there are 45 patients enrolled in the program. The MARP users have ordered 184 medications in the four months the program has been in use and have saved over \$13,000 in medication costs to the clinic! This program is of great benefit to our patients, many of whom require numerous medications to stay healthy.

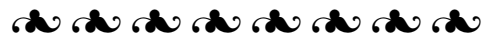
Mark Your Calendars!
