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The CARE Clinic = Help

There is no discrimination when it comes to lacking healthcare coverage; anyone can be affected. From maintenance workers to healthcare professionals, living without health insurance is a fact of life for many people in this community.

Darrel is one of these people. He works hard doing a little bit of everything as a maintenance worker. The hard physical labor his job requires is a struggle with the back problems and arthritis that plague him every day. He has had gout several times and has pulled muscles repeatedly.

"Now I pay the price," he says.

Darrel's been coming to The CARE Clinic so long that he can't even remember how he heard about it, but he's grateful for the care that enables him to keep working so he can afford food.

Without The CARE Clinic, he says, "I couldn't afford my pills. I couldn't afford nothing. If not for this place, I don't get help nowhere else."

Helen has been a CARE Clinic patient for at least five years, receiving treatment for bad teeth, anemia, pulled muscles, and simple colds. Anything The CARE Clinic providers can't do for her, participating hospitals and doctors' offices handle on referral.

"They help a lot because I don't have money to be getting medicine," Helen says. "It's a whole lot when you don't have nothing. It helps."

"From the bottom of my heart, thank you, thank you so much," she adds. "Because if it wasn't for them [CARE Clinic supporters], we'd have nowhere to go."

Wilma's work as a certified nursing assistant for a home health agency has never provided her the benefit of health insurance. This became an issue for her a year ago when she developed an abscessed tooth.

"A friend of mine told me about The CARE Clinic. They pulled my tooth for me and I sure did appreciate it because I didn't have money to go to a regular dentist," Wilma says.

More recently, because of a lull at work, Wilma wasn't able to afford to go back to the doctor who had been treating her high blood pressure. So she returned to The CARE Clinic, getting an appointment quickly enough to avoid a gap in her medical care. "I feel that The CARE Clinic is a godsend for someone like myself and other people who can't afford to go pay for [healthcare]," she says. "I'm just thankful for The CARE Clinic."
